My dear young sisters and brothers, grace and peace be to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen

Congratulations for choosing such an important and relevant theme of "Discipleship and Mission" for this Issue of our Berita, in line with our Diocesan Decade of Discipleship (2021 – 2030).

Do you know that before Christians were called "Christians", they were actually called "Disciples" (Acts 6:1; 11:26; 14:21; 18:27; John 13:35). Why is discipleship important for us today? Because being a disciple is our calling. God has called us not simply to become a Baptised and/or Confirmed Christian but to become a fully committed disciple and follower of Jesus. All of us – no matter how old or young we are - must intentionally grow in Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit. Discipleship programmes, of which there are several available - run by both the ADYC as well as our parishes, can help us to grow in maturity and wisdom, and build our faith on a strong foundation. This will give us the confidence to go and share Christ with others, as we take heed of Christ's command to "go and make disciples of all nations...." (Matthew 28:19)

Here then lies the close relationship between Discipleship and Mission. The final command from our Lord Jesus was simple, as he said, "All authority in heaven and earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey all I have commanded, And I will be with you always - even to the end of the age. (Matthew 28:18-20) Our clear mission is to make disciples. Only disciples can make new disciples!

I know some of you will be saying, "But I don't know how! I am not a professional." Have you ever wondered what it was like in the early days of the church? In the beginning nobody was a professional. Are you surprised? Good thing God had a plan that didn't require professionals. God uses ordinary people – like you. Some of them were very young! He did it to start the first movement of the church. And He does it today.

God wants you to be His disciples and He wants you to make new disciples.

SHARING ON MISSION

Shalom and Greetings, everyone. Let me thank the Berita ADYC team for asking me to share a few thoughts on the subject of Missions. Interestingly, I was just transferred back to my home parish of St. Andrew's BSB (Feb. 2022) and the church office found some photos of the first-ever youth mission trip in December 1998. I was one of the youth leaders then. That was a great trip and we served in Betong (& Skrang), Sri Aman, Abok & Quop:



The photos reminded me how missions became such an important agenda for my life, and why I strongly believe that EVERY YOUTH FELLOWSHIP and EVERY PARISH should have a mission agenda and undertake regular trips for themselves. Let me summarise 4 reasons what happens when we are involved in missions, using the word "M-I-S-I":

- M it MOBILISES them to practise/work out their faith
- I it takes the focus off the "I" (themselves) and shifts the attention onto others
- S it teaches them to rely on the SPIRIT of God in their lives as they love and serve others
- I it INSPIRES them about God when they see God in action through them

Let's go into the Bible. Interestingly, the Bible doesn't have the word 'missions'. Of course, we have 'The Great Commission' but that's not a verse in the Bible. That phrase is added or used to help us remember the command of our Lord Jesus to do the work of discipleship as stated in Matthew 28: 18 to 20. The work of going and making disciples is to be done in His name and with the Holy Spirit. This means, the work of missions is making disciples.

So then, what actually is Missions or the work of Discipleship? It is about demonstrating and establishing God's kingdom where we are and beyond. It is about allowing God to rule and reign in our lives and our situation, and sharing that (good news) with others so that they too may know their Creator and allow God to do the same work in their lives and situations. As this rule and reign become more established in our lives, we will begin to realise that it is not JUST about sharing the good news (gospel, berita manah, injil) of Jesus Christ. It usually starts there but there is MORE than just that.

This is where the five marks of mission is helpful. In the Anglican Communion, it's called the "Jesus-shaped Life", The five marks or action describes what mission is all about i.e. a holistic working-out of God's kingdom in a situation so as a disciple on mission for God, we are to do these five actions:

Tell: We proclaim the Good News of God's Reign!
Teach: We teach, baptise and nurture new believers
Tend: We respond to human need by loving service

Transform: We work to transform un-just structures of society, challenging violence of every kind and pursuing peace and reconciliation

Treasure: We strive to safeguard the integrity of creation, and to sustain and renew the life of the earth.

In our diocese, for our Decade of Discipleship (2021-30), we are adopting these 5 marks as part of our church mission. Let us all pray that as we progress through this decade, may we learn to Be More in Him and Do More for Him, as His disciples who are on His mission in our land and beyond. To God be the Glory!!

REGION 6 A NEW ADDITION TO OUR BIG FAMILY



Once out, I made my way to under the bridge to collect the things he had dropped. At that moment, I did not think about the van, the bridge or any possible dangers while I was below the bridge. God is merciful and His grace is great - He protected me from harm.

This sharing is not to discourage, but rather, to encourage us, as believers in Jesus, to do what He has commissioned us to do in Matthew 28:18-20. He will protect and provide us with strength and wisdom when we need it and while we do what He has called us to do. Therefore, do not worry or fear the unknown or if we will be able to do it or not. 
